Helen F. Agar, 92, of Lenox died Wednesday, December 26th at Berkshire Medical Center after a brief illness.

Born in Great Barrington, MA., on August 30, 1926 to the late Gordon and Ruth Bristol Forrest, she graduated from Searles High School.

Helen attended Westfield State College where she obtained her BA degree in education, and worked as a first and third grade school teacher for the Town of Lee public schools. She sought to foster the love of learning in each of her students, retiring in 1988 after twenty years of service.

She was a faithful member of the Church on the Hill for 61 years where she taught Sunday school and participated in community events.

She was an avid Red Sox and Celtics fan. She also enjoyed golfing, painting, gardening, and especially spending time with family and friends.

Mrs. Agar married Robert K. Agar Jr. on October 1, 1947 who pre-deceased her on April 1, 1981.
