Annie Bridget (Nancy) Carroll passed away on Tuesday, January 3, 2023, two days after her 101st birthday on New Years Day. Surrounded by loved ones, she will continue to be an inspiration to her family, neighbors, and the Lenox community.

Born in Roscommon, Ireland on New Year's Day of 1922, she emigrated to the Berkshires after World War II to stay with relatives. While working at the former Meadow Place in Lenox, a local doctor and his wife introduced her to her future husband Joseph J. Carroll who had recently moved to Lenox.
