Anthony Michael Gardino, 30, of Lenox, died Saturday morning at Berkshire Medical Center surrounded by his loving family.

Born in Pittsfield on April 15, 1986, the son of Michael J. and Martha J. Gardino, he attended local schools, was a 2004 graduate of Lenox Memorial High School. He furthered his education at Berkshire Community College earning his certificate in Culinary Arts in 2006, and his associates in Hotel-Restaurant Management in 2008.

Tony worked as a chef at various restaurants and was employed at Big Y Express in Lee for four years prior to his death.
