



## Mr Augustus A Roy, Jr

Augustus A. "Gus" Roy, Jr., 85, of Main Street died Wednesday morning at Springside Nursing and Rehabilitation Center surrounded by his loving family. Mr. Roy was born on June 4, 1930 to the late Augustus and Celia Vane Roy. He attended Lenox Schools earning his diploma in 1947. He attended Indiana University until he began his service in the United States Army from 1950-1952, serving in Korea. He was a recipient of the Purple Heart.

Gus was employed at Prudential Life Insurance for 23 years, where he worked as an Insurance Agent. Lastly, he owned and operated Lenox Laundromat for 20 years.

Gus was a communicant of St. Ann's Church.
