



Mr. Bruce W. Archibald

April 13, 1946 - March 25, 2012

Bruce Whitman Archibald, 65, of New Lenox Road, died Sunday, March 25, at Berkshire Medical Center following a brief illness. Born in Pittsfield April 13, 1946, the son of Dr. Frank W. Archibald and Helen F. Mandell Archibald, he attended Lenox schools, was a 1964 graduate of Lenox High School, and later earned his Bachelor of Science degree in Construction Management from Utica College at Syracuse University. Bruce was employed as a Field Engineer and Structural and Architectural Supervisor for David J. Tierney, Inc. of Pittsfield for many years, retiring in 2002. Prior to that he was employed at Petricca Construction as a Field Engineer, the Robert B. Deloye Co. as a Survey Party Chief, and George E. Maynard of Hancock as both Survey Party Chief and Draftsman. He was a member of the New Lenox Fire Co. from 1972 until his death and served as both a Lieutenant and Captain. He was skilled at carpentry, painting, and small engine repairs and took pride in his vegetable and flower gardens. He also enjoyed collecting fire-fighting memorabilia, antique restoration, Bruce is survived by his wife, Jane E. Exford Archibald, of Lenox, whom he married in Pittsfield August 2, 1980; one daughter, Heather L. Archibald of Pittsfield; and one brother, David N. Archibald of Ft. Gibson, OK. He was predeceased by his first wife, Donna L. Johnson, in 1976.
