Carlota Roman, 93, died peacefully on May 30, 2021 at her home in Stockbridge.

Born in Havana, Cuba on November 27, 1927 she attended local schools and moved to the United States in the 1950s. She first lived in Miami and then moved to New York where she worked as a banker in Manhattan.

After retiring from the banking industry, Carlota settled permanently into her summer home where she was a friend to many and enjoyed attending concerts and shows at Tanglewood and other local attractions. She taught CCD for a number of years at St. Ann's parish and was devoted to the National Shrine of the Divine Mercy in Stockbridge, Massachusetts.
