Charles "Chuck" Moss Redfern, 84, of Kimball Farms Retirement Community, 235 Walker St., died Saturday evening at Berkshire Medical Center. Born in New Jersey, Dec. 19, 1927, son of John and Esther Moss Redfern, he attended South Orange schools, was a 1945 graduate of Columbia High School, and a 1950 graduate of Drew University in Madison, NJ. A veteran of World War II, Mr. Redfern served for 18 months as a Navy Corpsman in various naval hospitals from 1945 until his honorable discharge in 1946. Mr. Redfern enjoyed a career in the insurance industry and worked for many years as a computer specialist for the Aetna Insurance Co. in Hartford, CT., retiring in 1991.
