



## Mr. Charles E Thompson

December 26, 1932 - November 13, 2024

Charles E. Thompson, Jr., 91, died Wednesday morning at Springside of Pittsfield.

Born in Minden, West Virginia, December 26, 1932, the son of Charles E. and Elizabeth Lokant Thompson, he attended local schools and was a 1951 high school graduate. Following his military service he attended the West Virginia Institute of Technology, graduating in May 1960, with a degree in Printing management.

Mr. Thompson was a US Airforce veteran serving from 1951 until his honorable discharge in 1955, with one year in Korea. He was employed at Lenox Machine Co. as a machinist for over 20 years, retiring several years ago. He had previously worked at Ben Franklin Press and Textron.

He was a Member of First Baptist Church and was member and past Master of the Masonic Lodge, both of Pittsfield. He also enjoyed the outdoors, hunting and fishing, and travelling.

Mr. Thompson and his wife, Marion Batho Thompson, were married August 23, 1959. She pre-deceased her husband on June 10, 2021. He is survived by his two sons; Chuck Thompson of Suwanee, GA, and Frederick C. Thompson (Perri) of Nashua, NH; four granddaughters and four great-grandchildren.
