David Michael Barry, 65, of Lenox, died Thursday morning at Berkshire Medical Center.

A life-long Lenox resident, he was born in Pittsfield May 7, 1956, the seventh of eight children born to Edward and Helen White Barry. He attended local schools, was a 1974 graduate of Lenox Memorial High School and received the "Golden Hammer Award" for outstanding achievement in Industrial Arts at the graduation ceremony.

Just out of High School, David went to work at Lenox Machine Co., working there many years and he eventually became a Maintenance Mechanic for paper making machinery. He later was employed by Graham Engineering and Polymatrix.

He was a member of the Lenox Fire Co. as well as SPAMFA, a national organization dedicated to preserving antique motorized fire apparatus.

David was an exceptionally talented carpenter, woodworker and mechanic who was always ready to help a friend work on a project or fix something in need of repair.
