Dorothy Carol Bacha, 89, of 235 Walker Street in Lenox, MA, died Saturday morning at the Mt. Greylock Extended Care Facility in Pittsfield, MA. Born in Scranton, PA, September 7, 1933, daughter to Matthew and Cecelia Bocinski Golembeski, she was a 1951 graduate of East Side High School in Newark, NJ.

She was a homemaker and executive assistant for much of her career, eventually retiring from Chubb Insurance in Warren, NJ, to enjoy traveling with her husband, Michael J.
