Mr. Frederick A. Bonak, 87, a long time resident of Stockbridge, passed away on Thursday, July 16th after a long illness. He was a graduate of Searles High School Class of 1950, the General Electric Drafting Certification Program, and was a long time communicant of St. Ann Church in Lenox.

Mr. Bonak served as a Corporal in the tank division of The United States Army post Korean War. He was employed by the General Electric Company in Pittsfield, MA where he worked in the Power Transformer and Naval Ordnance Divisions before retiring in 1989.
