Harriet C. Barry, 82, of Stockbridge and Boston, died Saturday at Berkshire Medical Center. Born in Medford, MA on January 22, 1933, the daughter of Frederick and Dorothy McLaughlin Clark, she was a 1950 graduate of Medford High School, earned her Bachelor of Arts degree from Radcliffe College in Cambridge in 1954 and later received a Master's degree in Library Science from Villanova (PA) University. Before retiring, she worked as a research analyst in the financial services industry. After college, she moved to Brooklyn and then Villanova, PA before returning to her hometown of Boston in 2005. She spent all her summers since 1964 in Stockbridge. Harriet was a communicant of St. Ann's Church in Lenox and Our Lady of Victories in Boston. She was a member of the Harvard-Radcliffe Club of Boston and past president of the Harvard-Radcliffe Clubs of New York City and Philadelphia; she was a member of the St. Botolph Club and the Handel & Hayden Society, both of Boston, was a Friend of Tanglewood, and a former Chesterwood volunteer. She was predeceased by her husband, Robert A.J. Barry in 1986. Harriet is survived by her children; Robert A.J. Barry, Jr. and his wife, Maria Park of Weston, Justin A. Barry and his wife, Maria of Westfield, NJ, and Antonia J.
