



Mr. Henry E. Sedgwick

October 1, 1930 - January 13, 2022

Henry Edward Sedgwick, 91, of Lee died Thursday, January 13, 2022 at Hillcrest Commons where he had resided for the past year.

Born on October 13, 1930 in Pittsfield, MA., to the late Thomas and Alma Houser Sedgwick, he was a 1948 graduate of Lenox High School.

After high school, Henry enlisted in the United States Army and served during the Korean War. He was honorably discharged on December 21, 1953 with the rank of Corporal.

Henry worked as an auto mechanic for various places, Bull's Chevy, UPS, Lenox Machine Co., and Lenox Dale Service Station, retiring in the early 1990s.

Mr. Sedgwick loved swimming, bike riding, and walking. He was an avid guitar player and loved country music.
