Jacqueline M. Miller, 97, of Lenox died Thursday morning, February 16th at Berkshire Medical Center.

She became an avid gardener, accomplished cook, skilled needle worker and early environmentalist. Though she never drove a car or flew in an airplane, Mrs. Miller traveled often to France and throughout Europe. She loved spending time in Nantucket where she had many friends.

She was passionate about fighting injustice and helping others less fortunate. She encouraged an entrepreneurial can-do spirit and always loved to tell a story.

She is survived by her children, Michele Miller of Monterey and her husband Peter Murkett and their son Riley Murkett, Nicole Miller and her husband Kim and their son Palmer of New York City, and Alan Miller and his partner Natalia de Amorim of Canaan, NY.

Besides her parents, she was predeceased by her husband Grier B. Miller in January of 2013.
