James Richard Prince, Sr., 81, died Monday April 2, 2018 at Berkshire Medical Center surrounded by his loving family.

Mr. Prince was born on January 23, 1937 in Pittsfield to the late Edward and Alicia Dunn Prince. He was a 1955 graduate of St. Joseph's High School. After high school, Jim enlisted in the United States Marine Corp and was honorably discharged in 1963. He worked for many years as an Assembly Supervisor in Sales for Lenox Machine Co.

Mr. Prince was a communicant of St. Ann's church and a member of the Fr. William F. Davitt Council Knights of Columbus. He enjoyed bird watching, was a family man, and enjoyed camping with his family.

He and his wife, Marjorie A. Huber, were married on September 20, 1958 at St. Ann's Church in Lenox.

Besides his wife of Lenox, he is survived by his children: Regina M. Boino (David) of Dalton, James R. Prince, Jr., (Kathleen) of Lenox Dale; grandchildren Andrew, Gregory, Heather, and Matthew Boino, and Meaghan and Conor Prince; his brother, Francis Prince (Zolita) of San Francisco, CA.; and several nieces and nephews.

Besides his parents Jim is pre-deceased by brothers and sisters.
