Jane E. Archibald, 77, of Lenox died Tuesday, June 5, 2018 at her home after a brief illness.

Mrs. Archibald was born on September 7, 1940 in Pittsfield, MA to the late Robert and Lois Streeter Exford. She attended Pittsfield High School and was a 1958 graduate.

After high school, Jane worked as a Legal Secretary for the Law Office of Claffie & Sullivan until her retirement in 2013.
