Jo Anne Huntley Magee of 751 East Road died peacefully on Tuesday afternoon at Kimball Farms Nursing home. She was born on September 23, 1948 in Findlay, Ohio, the daughter of Emmett L. Huntley and Florence (George) Huntley. Jo Anne attended Ohio and West Virginia schools before receiving her Nursing BS degree in 1970 from West Virginia University. She later received a masters in public health from the University of Michigan. She had a long career in health care mostly in management positions culminating at Blue Cross/Blue shield of Michigan and then Health Dialogue of Boston until 2010. Jo Anne's primary residence for the past 14 years was in Lenox and Richmond (a boundary line home). She served on the Lenox Affordable housing committee, the Lenox Zoning Board of Appeals and most recently on the Lenox School Committee. She was also active in the Richmond gardeners, was a former contributor for the Richmond Record and was active in the Lenox Club and other social and charitable groups in the Berkshires. Jo Anne is survived by her husband of 20 years, Chris Magee and by her three sisters, Barbara Dorian of Columbus, Ohio (husband, Ken and son, Patrick Dorian), Mary Huntley of Charleston, W.V. (husband, Mark Snyder and daughter, Erin) and Carol Huntley of Ypsilanti, Michigan (spouse, Ronda Hemingway, daughters, Maggie and Katie Huntley).
