Joan Agnes Bailey, 89, of Lenox, died Tuesday afternoon at Kimball Farms Nursing Care Center.

Born in Pittsfield January 11, 1933, the daughter of Arthur and Agnes McCabe Roberts, she attended local schools and was a 1950 graduate of Pittsfield High School.

Joan was employed for 28 years at the former Edgecombe Nursing Home in Lenox where she worked with patients in the physical therapy department, retiring several years ago.

She and her husband, Carlson B. Bailey, were married in St. Theresa's Church in Pittsfield on November 8, 1952. Mr. Bailey predeceased her December 17, 1989.

Joan and her husband raised their family in Lenox Dale where she was a communicant of St. Vincent de Paul Parish for many years.

She is survived by her four daughters; Deborah A. Strycharz of Westfield, Susan J. Casey (Robert) of Lenox Dale, Catherine Perry (Mark) of Pittsfield, and Ellen M.
