John J. Hurley Jr. (Jack) of Lenox passed away at Berkshire Medical Center of complications from kidney disease on February 14, 2023. He died peacefully surrounded by his family.

Born in Pittsfield on January 15, 1942. He was the second of eleven children of the late John and Mary Rennie Hurley. He served in the US Army as a member of the 101st Airborne from 1959-1962.

He married the love of his life Estella Morse on July 24, 1963. They would have celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary this July. They went on to have 3 children who were the center of Jack's world. He was extremely proud of his children and grandchildren. The family resided in Becket where Jack coached Little League and was

often found outdoors enjoying nature. He worked at the Mead Paper Co. in Lee for 34 years, retiring in 1997. Stella and Jack retired to Leesburg, FL for 15 years. They returned to Lenox in 2013.
