Joseph R. Leahey, 83, of Lenox died Thursday, September 28, 2017 at his home.

Joe was born on April 3, 1934 in Lee, MA to the late Thomas C. and Mary Malloy Leahey. Joe graduated from St. Mary's School and was a 1952 graduate of Lee High School.

After high school Joe worked for May Engineering before enlisting in the United States Army. He was honorably discharged on August 8, 1958 with Rank of PFC.

Mr. Leahey worked for the Town of Lee in the water department and was self-employed as an Auto Mechanic. He could always be found around the family farm working on things, he loved being there.

His wife, the former Frances T. Martin predeceased him on October 22, 1991. They were married on October 19, 1968 at St. Vincent de Paul church in Lenox Dale.
