



## Keith Roberts

September 10, 1946 - January 24, 2012

Keith Winfield Roberts, 65, of 32 Old Stockbridge Road, died Tuesday at his home.

Born in Milton, Mass., September 10, 1946, the son of Willard and Evelyn Alexander Roberts, he attended local schools and was a 1966 graduate of Lenox High School.

Mr. Roberts was a US Air Force veteran of the Vietnam War and was honorably discharged as a Sergeant on September 23, 1970.

He was employed as a welder for Lenox Machine and Beloit Lenox for twenty years before opening and operating a motel in Vassar, Michigan. Mr. Roberts enjoyed golf, hockey, fishing, and was a standout pitcher for the Lenox High baseball team .
