Kourtney Erin Yeaman, 22, of East Street, Lee, died Monday at Bay State Medical Center in Springfield.

Born in Pittsfield July 13, 1993, the daughter of James Yeaman and the late Barbara Phipps Yeaman, she attended Berlin Jr. and Sr. High School in Berlin, New York.

Kourtney earned her Certified Nurses Training Certification and had been employed as a C N A at Hillcrest Commons in Pittsfield.

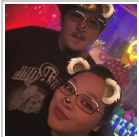
