Louise Bergan, 78, of Lenox died Saturday, April 1, 2017 at Kimball Farms Nursing Care Center where she had been a resident for the past few months. She was born in Pittsfield on February 17, 1939 to the late Marian Shaul Bergan and Dr. Carl Bergan. Dr. Carl Bergan was a longtime Lenox physician. Louise attended local schools graduating from Oak Grove School in Waterville, ME in 1957. After high school, Louise attended Colby Junior College in Maine and New England School of Art in Boston earning a Bachelor's Degree. She worked as an Administrative Assistant for the United Nations until her retirement in 1996. During her thirty years with the UN, she took advantage of the travel and assignments abroad offered by her position. She was a talented artist, and although she did not make a career of her art, she spent many hours sketching interesting faces and designs. Louise returned to Lenox to live in 2008 and her last years were spent at Kimball Farms.

Louise enjoyed reading, traveling, and visiting her extended family. She spent the majority of her life living in New York City where she enjoyed the excitement and opportunities afforded by living there.

Louise's family is very grateful for the loving care she received in the LEP unit at Kimball Farms and in the Kimball Farms Nursing Care Center. Hospice Care of the Berkshires also provided wonderful additional support and care.
