



## Mrs. M. Judith Jordan

M. Judith "Nana" Jordan, 77, of Lenox Dale, died Wednesday evening at Berkshire Medical Center.

Born in Pittsfield May 5, 1945, the daughter of Vincent and Arlene Grant Atkinson, she attended local schools and was a 1963 graduate of Pittsfield High School.
