Margaret Anne "Margie" Merrick, 81, of Lenox, died peacefully on Saturday, August 23, 2025, at Mount Carmel Care Center.

Born March 23, 1944, in Washington, D.C., she was the daughter of the late Richard Lawrence and Margaret Charlotte (Kestel) Merrick. Margaret graduated with highest honors from Stone Ridge Country Day School in 1961 and attended the Massachusetts Institute of Technology on scholarship.
