Marie Judd, 92 of Lenox, MA passed away on May 5th.

She was born in Staten Island, NY, and graduated from Curtis High School and Notre Dame College (where she was the president of her senior class and graduated with honors).

She married the love of her life, Richard (Dick) Judd, in 1947. After raising their family in Staten Island, they purchased the Village Inn in Lenox in 1970 and became successful innkeepers entertaining guests until its sale in 1984.
