Marie Yvonne Kergaravat, 84, of Stockbridge, died July 10, 2013, at Fairview Commons in Great Barrington.

Born in Le Cloitre- Pleyben, France January 23, 1929, she was the daughter of Jean Louis and Marie Jeanne Suignard Le Guern. She attended a Catholic boarding school for girls and two years of lycee (a secondary school between elementary school and college) while in France.

Mrs. Kergaravat came to this country in 1953, and was employed by the Kimberly Clark Corporation in Lee for 29 years, retiring in 1994.

She attended St. Ann's Church in Lenox for many years. She enjoyed her family, home, animals, the outdoors, working in her flower garden, and shopping for furniture.
