



## Mrs Mary Loretta Duval

April 7, 1928 - September 29, 2018

Mary Loretta (Forget) Duval, 90, of Lenox, died peacefully Saturday morning at Mount Carmel Care Center with her family at her side.

Born in Pittsfield on April 7, 1928, the daughter of Mathias T. and Yvonne Davis Forget, she attended local catholic schools and was a 1946 graduate of St. Joseph's High School.

Primarily a mother and homemaker, she worked briefly prior to her marriage for General Electric Co. in Pittsfield in the payroll department.

She was a communicant of St. Ann's Church and a member of the Catholic Daughters of America. She adored family gatherings and especially enjoyed Christmas eve singalongs each year with her family.
