



## Mary Verchot

Mary Hughes Verchot, 74, of Lenox, died Monday morning at her home with her husband by her side. Born in Pittsfield Aug. 27, 1937, daughter of Henry M. and Margaret Hughes Parker, she was a life-long Lenox resident and 1955 graduate of Lenox High School. Mrs. Verchot was employed at the former Lenox Savings Bank, later Legacy Banks, for 30 years, retiring in 1999 as head teller.
