home. She was strong, classy, funny and dignified. As much as she liked a fantastic time, she also could be tough as nails and firm in her beliefs. She could debate with the best of them. She was well informed and let you know it. She would zip through at least two crossword puzzles a day. Norma loved all animals and always had a dog and several cats nearby. Her little dog Leo and cat Simba will miss her treats and love.
