Pamela D. Smith, 81, of Manhattan, died Tuesday morning at her home. Born in New York City February 23, 1933, the daughter of Robert and Ethel Dunton Smith, she grew up in Lenox where she attended local schools and was a 1950 graduate of the former Williams High School in Stockbridge. Pamela attended the University of Michigan and later earned her PhD in Anthropology from the New School in New York. For much of her career she was a professor of anthropology at Pace University in Manhattan. One of her main joys in life was spending time with her niece and nephews and grand-niece and grand-nephews, and she also enjoyed literature, especially poetry. She is survived by her brother, Judge Robert S. Smith, retired, and wife, Dian, of New York; and her sister, Rev. Nora Smith and husband, Alan Bronston, of Irvington.
