Peter F. Borgnis, 57, of Washington passed away on March 22 at Berkshire Medical Center after a brief and unexpected illness.

He was born on February 21, 1957 in Pittsfield to Richard and Anita Borgnis. He was a class of 1975 graduate of Wahconah Regional High School, and a graduate of Springfield Technical Community College, receiving a degree in chemical engineering. He married Maureen Kane of Lenox on May 11, 1985. Peter was the owner and operator of Lenox Lumber, taking over the business after his father's untimely death in 1982. He was also the President and co-owner of Borgnis & Son in Lee, MA along with his sister, Rose.

Peter was a pillar in his community. He volunteered for many years as the baseball coach and sponsor of Galusha and Babe Ruth baseball teams, was involved with the town of Washington's Finance Committee, was a member of the Lenox Lion's Club for many years, and made many donations to various charitable organizations. His passion in life was his family and friends, and his greatest joys were in being active in his children's lives and acting as a role model to all who met him.
