Phyllis R. Fuore, 93, of Lenox passed away peacefully at Hillcrest Commons on Friday, June 16.

She was born on April 27, 1930 in Hudson, New York to the late Rose and Anthony Mastrangelo. Phyllis attended Pittsfield High School, graduating in 1948. Phyllis married the late Julian D. (Babe) Fuore in 1950. He predeceased her in 1986.

Phyllis was the proprietor of Fuore's Market in Lenox, a neighborhood landmark in the 50's and 60's. She later worked at Country Curtains in Lee, Ma. After retirement, she worked as a childcare provider for many years. In addition to her own beloved grandchildren, she became honorary "Gram" to the children in her care. More than anything, Phyllis enjoyed spending time with her friends and family. She was a familiar fan at her grandchildren's sporting events and was quick to make friends wherever she went.

Phyllis is survived by her children; Maureen Dayal, William Fuore and his wife Rebecca, her grandchildren; Natasha Egan, Julian Dayal and his wife Safie, Nicholas Dayal, Robert Fuore and Daniel Fuore. She is survived also by her cherished great grandchildren; Luke, Sienna, and Amelia, who are now responsible for the preservation of "Gram's" meatball recipe.

She was predeceased by her son, John M. Fuore, in 2018. Phyllis was also predeceased by her siblings, Silvio Mastrangelo and Jeanette Ringie.
