



Mr. Richard F. Kirby

January 31, 1934 - March 1, 2025

Richard F. Kirby, 91, of Lenox, died Saturday at Kimball Farms Nursing Care Center.

Born in Pittsfield January 31, 1934, the son of Henry and Madeline Burchard Kirby, he attended Lenox schools and was a 1951 graduate of Lenox High School.

Mr. Kirby served in the US Army during the Korean War and was stationed in Germany for much of his service.

He was employed by Lenox Savings Bank throughout his career and was Senior Vice-President and Treasurer at the time of his retirement in 1995.

Mr. Kirby was a communicant of St. Ann's Church and was on the board of the Lenox Housing Authority. An avid golfer he was a member of Cranwell Country Club for many years.

He and his wife, Mildred Hall Kirby, were married at St. Mary's Church in Pittsfield on June 7, 1958.

Besides his wife of Lenox he is survived by one son Daniel T. Kirby (Kim) of Lenox, and one daughter Stacy A. Kirby of Forrest Ranch, CA; one sister Mrs. Nancy A. Sorrell of Lenox; two grandchildren and 1 great-grandchild. Besides his parents he was pre-deceased by his brother Robert Kirby.

The funeral of Mr. Richard F. Kirby of Lenox will be Friday morning at 11 am at St. Ann's Church in Lenox with the Rev. Monsignor John J.
