



## Robert F. Connor

Robert F. Connor, 80, died Friday morning at Berkshire Medical Center. He was pre-deceased by his wife, the former Barbara Joan LeClair in 1988. Born in Brooklyn, NY, Jan. 15, 1934, the son of Joseph E. and Grace A. Fahey Connor, he was a 1952 graduate of Catholic Central High School in Pittsburgh and earned his B.S. degree in Business Administration from Duquesne University in 1957. Mr. Connor was a United States Army veteran of the Vietnam War, serving as a Logistics Coordinator, retiring as a Lieutenant Colonel following 20 years of honorable service. After retiring from the Army Bob continued to provide logistics support while working in Saudi Arabia for 15 years as a US Government contractor. Mr. Connor was a communicant of St. Ann's Church in Lenox and also enjoyed volunteering for the Salvation Army in Pittsfield. He is survived by two sons; Gregory L. Connor of Kailua, Hawaii and his wife, Sheireen Dunlap, and Jeffrey L. Connor of Lenox; one daughter, Dona A.
