



Mr. Robert G. Meaney

June 12, 1941 - March 12, 2023

Robert George Meaney, 81, of Lenox, died Sunday at Fairview Commons in Great Barrington.

Born in North Adams June 12, 1941, the son of Thomas and Louise Dach Meaney. Bob Graduated from Drury High School in 1958. Upon graduation Bob enlisted in the Navy where he served four years as a welder and pipe fitter on a NORAD ship. After the Navy, Bob would go on to spend over 45 years working for Verizon, holding positions as an in-home installer and pay phone technician before retiring as a lineman.

Bob loved the outdoors and could often be found hiking and working around the home he and his wife Liz built on October Mountain. Bob was a creator who could repair anything. Hand him a piece of fabric, leather, wood, or metal and he would hand back a purse, rocking chair, or an exceptionally robust mail box.

Bob and his wife, Elizabeth Ann Burke Meaney, met in January of 1968 while they were both working for the New England Telephone Company. They were

married Sept. 28 that same year. They shared countless adventures and cherished each other's company until Liz's sudden death 48 years later.

Robert Meaney is survived by his two sisters; Susan M Dickey of Wilmington NC and Betty-Ann Trudeau of Niceville FL. And his three children; Todd M. Meaney of San Luis Obispo CA, Erin E. Meaney of Pittsfield, Shaun R. Meaney of Lenox. And his grandson Justin C Meaney of Denver CO.

A graveside funeral service will be held Thursday, March 23 at 11 am in Mountain View Cemetery in Lenox. Calling hours at the ROCHE FUNERAL HOME will be Wednesday March 22nd from 5-7 pm.
