Rosalind F. Haywood (Squeegie), 85, of Lee died peacefully at Lee Healthcare on Thursday morning.

She was born on February 13, 1938 in Florence, MA., to the late Lincoln and Clara Frulla Streeter. She attended St. Mary's School and Lee High School.

Rosalind, along with her daughter Susan, owned and operated Pippin's Florist. She was employed by The Morgan House, the former Village Inn and Marskandiser's Florist leaving all these places with lifelong friends.

Rosalind was a communicant of St. Vincent de Paul Church in Lenox Dale. She enjoyed oil painting, playing bridge with her very close friends, Norma Flynn, Alice Halpin, Gloria Brazee and Clara Gennari for many years. Laughter filled the air when they were together. Rosalind married Paul F. Haywood on July 2, 1955 in St. Vincent de Paul

Church. He predeceased her on March 6, 2001.
