Timothy deViry Strong, 76, died on June 6th after a brief illness. Tim was a retired banker who worked in the business services section of Bank of America for many years in Buffalo, New York. He had previously worked for several smaller banks, in Lee and Albany among other locations, that were all eventually absorbed by Bank of America.

Tim grew up in Highland Park, NJ and graduated from Rutgers Prep School in 1967. He then attended Ithaca College Class of 1971 where he became active in the Vietnam Anti-War Movement. He would remain a champion of progressive causes ever after.

Tim was predeceased by his parents Woodbridge and Julie Strong of Lenox, MA and his brother Alan. He is survived by his brothers, Harmon of Lee, MA., and Benjamin of Belle Mead, NJ., and Great Barrington, MA., along with four nieces, a nephew, and seven grand nieces and nephews.
