William Samuel Maynard, Jr., 92, died on Saturday, November 6, 2021 at Berkshire Medical Center after a brief illness, surrounded by his loving family. Born on January 2, 1929 in Hancock, MA., to the late William and Bertha Halden Maynard, he attended local schools.

William worked as a truck driver for Suburban Propane for 35 years and later drove for Larabee Fuel in New Lebanon, NY for 12 years.

Bill enlisted in the U.S. Army in June 1946 and served in Co. B 8th Regiment during WWII. He was honorably discharged on December 23, 1946.

Mr. Maynard married Anna Derby on May 15, 1965 in New Lebanon, NY., she pre-deceased him on November 12, 2009.
